105-2 Old Testament Survey 4 – Proverbs - Song of Songs (Professor White) 7:00 to 9:00 p.m. Tuesdays

This course focuses on how to apply and teach the wisdom books of the Old Testament, covering Proverbs through the Song of Songs. Topics include apologetics, biblical worldview, character development, charity, courage, ethics, expository preaching, faith, love, marriage, prophecy, servant-leadership, sex, suffering, trust, virtue, wisdom, and worship. Deals with authorship, date, historical context, literary forms, themes, and applications. Students will create visual projects and applications for transformational discipleship and leadership.

466-5 Doctrine of Heaven (Instructor) TBA 7:00 to 9:00 p.m. Mondays

This course focuses on the doctrine of heaven as a source of comfort and hope: Randy Alcorn. Topics include looking forward to heaven, the nature of the present heaven, why the resurrection is so important, our relationship with God in heaven, ruling on the new earth, what our relationships will be like, what we will do in heaven, and applications for preaching. Students will create visual projects and applications for transformational discipleship and leadership.

473-2 Living with Confidence: Biblical Worldview (Instructor) TBA 7:00 to 9:00 p.m. Tuesdays

This course focuses on how to live with confidence in a chaotic world. Topics include expository preaching by David Jeremiah; character development; and staying calm, compassionate, constructive, challenged, connected, centered, confident, consistent, committed, and convinced in a confusing world. Students will complete the study guide and participate in teaching and/or preaching for transformational discipleship and leadership.
